Speed and accuracy proved to be vital skills to success in the 2008 CAMI Speed Challenge, a Mathematics competition that attracted a crowd of more than 450 on Sunday, 19 October at the Garden Route Mall. The platform for a spectacular day was set and 122 courageous learners (from gr. 1 to 11) from 34 schools across the Southern Cape came with great loads of brains and brawn to compete in their respective age groups.

The event was preceded by qualifying rounds at school level where thousands of learners took part, and only the top performing learners were invited back to the action packed final.
